

GOLF CANADA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

PINEBROOK GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB LOCAL RULES

1. Parking lots and roadways between holes are out of bounds.
2. A ball striking any power line on the course **MUST** be replayed without penalty under Rule 33-8/13. A ball striking the power pole or support wires is rub of the green and the ball must be played as it lies.
3. Free drop must be taken for the following under Rule 33-8:
 - a. staked trees (including stakes, wires and trees), all around flower beds as well as the green nursery to the right of #9
 - b. waterfall bed located left of #17 green (only if ball is found).
You **MUST** drop the ball within one club length from the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole, with no penalty.
4. 150 yard markers are immovable obstructions (See rule 24-2b).
5. **MANDATORY** relief from environmentally sensitive area on holes 13, 14 and 15 defined by green capped hazard stakes. Penalty of one stroke, Rule 26-1.
6. Hole 17: As an additional option under the Rule 26-1, the drop zone may be used when taking relief from the water hazard.
7. If a ball lies through the green, and an immovable obstruction interferes on or within two club lengths of the putting green, the player may take relief under Rule 24-2. If the player's ball lies on the putting green, interference also occurs if an immovable obstruction (ie: sprinkler head) on the putting green intervenes on the line of the putt.

Power Carts **MUST** remain on cart paths where provided.
All Power Carts **MUST** stay at least 30 feet from the greens.

THOR GUARD LIGHTNING PROTECTION SYSTEM

One prolonged blast of the horn (15 seconds) indicated that play is suspended and golfers are encouraged to seek shelter by returning to the clubhouse or finding shelter in a building (maintenance building, hallway house or washrooms on #3 and #15).

Three short blasts (5 seconds) indicates that it is safe to resume your position on the golf course. Both the #1 and #10 tees are closed immediately upon the horn sounding to suspend play. Play on the golf course is suspended as well and if players choose to continue, they will be doing so at their own risk and against the advice of the club. Consequently, they are considered out of order and the players going back out after the all clear signal shall get the right to their original position on the golf course at the time of play suspension.
